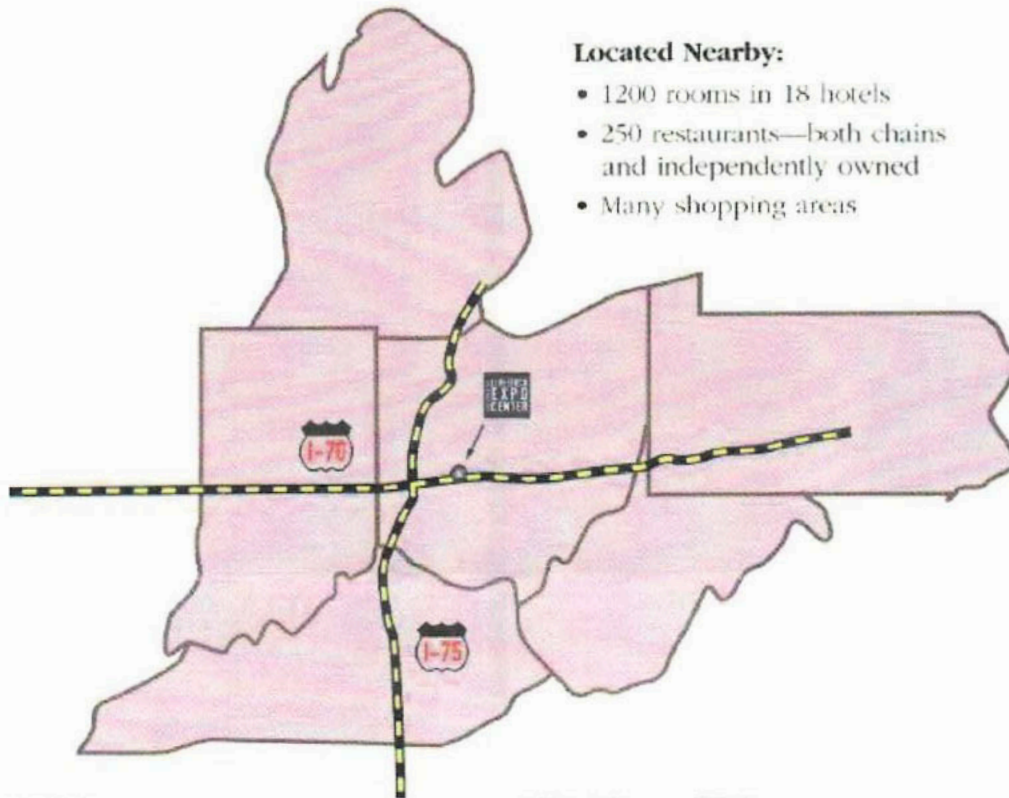

\$50 – 6 Jackpot Classes, \$500 payout to top 3, 1st \$300, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$50

Stalls/Tack Rooms, **NO** first bedding, \$75 weekend per stall

Early Arrivals/Late Departures, \$35 per stall/per day

Any exhibitor arriving prior to move in (one day prior of the event) or staying after the show, will be considered a LAYOVER and subject to additional fees for stalls and camping. Minimum lights and heat are provided in the barn area. The outdoor arenas will be available for exhibitors use. The indoor arena remains closed until move in day.

All layovers must make arrangements in advance with the facility.

Grounds Fee \$15 per horse, per day (no stall) – No horses will be allowed to tie overnight to trailers. It is Prohibited!

Office Fee \$15 per horse

Vendors indoors/outdoors \$100/weekend

RV or Camper Hook-up \$45/night

(Any water, gray or otherwise, dumped in campground area is prohibited and will result in \$500. Fine PER Camper.)

Show management reserves the right to refuse entry to the show, or show grounds, to ANYONE, exhibitor or spectator, for any reason, without liability of compensation.

Show Rules, Entry Fees & Stabling Information

Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse **ANY** entries for **ANY** reason, cancel, combine or divide a class, alter the proposed time schedule or substitute Officials if necessary. Judge has full power to divide a class for working purposes if decided for safety issues. Judges decision is final. Prizelist is subject to change at anytime.

Horse Show Office: Will be open for Summer Solstice Soiree on Thursday for check-in, hours tbd.. The office will be open Friday at least 1 hour prior to the first session start time, and will remain open for one hour after the last class each day.

Entry Fees:

\$20 Entry Fee, SHIH-Sport Horse In Hand, Liberty & OTAB-Open To All Breeds, Ohio 4H ruled classes. **These classes are NOT 4H member only classes. Open to EVERYONE, they are only governed by 4H rules for the class specifications!**

Six Jackpot classes, Entry Fee is \$50 – 1st place wins \$300, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$50.

All other classes \$25 Entry Fee

To be accepted, the entry blank must be **COMPLETELY** filled out and accompanied by:

A check covering all fees

A negative coggins test dated within a year of show dates, and for out of state horses, a current health certificate.

Also must include copy of (where applicable) horse's registration papers or lease release proving ownership

This all must be presented with entries **BEFORE** back numbers are issued. In the case of a minor the entry blank must be signed by the parent or guardian. If there is no trainer, the entry blank must be signed by the owner.

Management reserves the right to split any class 12 or more. Small Fry **WILL** be split at 12. Splits will be completely random. Management also reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, and to cancel award prizes, with claims for damages: to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classed; and to change judges or other officials at any time for any reason as needed.

Breed Association Points: It will be up to you as an exhibitor/owner to make sure all membership numbers, registration papers etc are **Included with Entry Forms. (Saddlebreds, Saddlebred Select Series. Dutch Harness Horses, Friesians)** Same for any special breed organization forms needed for points. It will be the exhibitor/owner's responsibility to present completed appropriate form to show office for validation, before you to send to your organization for points. It will not be the responsibility of the show or any show officials to make sure your entries qualify you for points.

Closing Date: Entries close Tuesday, May 28, 2024, and must be postmarked by that date. Any entries received after this date will be considered post entries and must pay a \$25 per horse post-entry fee.

Open Checks: The horse show requires that a signed open check be left with the entry office for all tab accounts. No back numbers will be issued without an open check. Upon failure to settle accounts, the horse show secretary will fill in the correct amount on the open check and the exhibitor or agent relinquishes the right of adjustment after leaving the show.

Buy a Class: A total of four slots have been built in for added classes. These are available on a first come, first serve basis at \$25 each. When buying a class, you are sponsoring a class of your choosing to be added to the show. You will **STILL** have to pay entry fee to enter said class. The deadline for Buy a Class is Tuesday, May 28, 2024. Any buy a classes after May 28 will be at the rate of \$50 per class if slots are available. Contact Lynn Schmidt about availability and adding classes. ALL "Buy a Class" requests **MUST** be approved by Lynn Schmidt.

Stalls and Stall Reservations: Stalls and tack stalls are \$75 each if reserved and paid for by Tuesday May 28. No stalls will be assigned until the stall payment is received. No open checks or phone calls will be accepted for stall reservations. Stalls will be available for check in Thursday June 13, 2024. Arrivals before Thursday must notify Sue Cooke in advance at (330) 475-5773 and will be assessed an early arrival fee of \$35 per day per stall.

Stall Assignment Policy: Stalls will be assigned by the show management to most efficiently use available stalls.

Refunding of Fees: A full refund will be given to anyone who cancels their entries before the closing date, May 28, 2024. *After the closing date, stall refunds will be given only if the stalls are re-rented.* Entry fees will be refunded to anyone who cancels up to one (1) hour prior to the start of the session in which they are showing. Once the office has closed for the session, no fees will be refunded. Fees will not be refunded when an entry misses their class.

Card fee 4%

Returned Checks: All returned checks will be charged a \$50 return check fee.

Bedding: Bedding will be available for purchase from the TizWiz, reached at 937-325-4667, \$9.00 per bag, 2 bag minimum. An open check or payment will be required for orders placed during the show. Bedding may also be ordered for pre-arrival delivery on the enclosed entry form. Payment must accompany pre-arrival orders. No outside bedding deliveries allowed.

Coggins: A negative coggins test current within one (1) year of the show must accompany each horse. Proof will be required when picking up back numbers. If possible, please send a copy with your entries to expedite office time.

Warm-Up Ring Procedure: The next class on the schedule has priority for use of the warm-up ring.

Ring Procedure: The gate to the show ring will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Barn calls must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no missed class protest will be upheld nor will any section be changed.

Proper Attire: All riders, drivers, and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed when entering the ring.

Stable Area: Gas, electric, or propane heaters; propane tanks; hot plates; and air conditioners are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12-gauge, three-prong, and prong negative type.

Attention-Getting Devices: Items such as tape measures, blow horns, split bamboo poles, whistles, or whips longer than six (6) feet that would alter the performance of a horse or disturb another horse will not be allowed at the entrance of the show ring, ring-side, or in the warm-up rings. Explosives, fire extinguishers, and laser light beams are prohibited on the show grounds before, during, and after the show. Stewards who have the authority to confiscate items will be observing; anyone in violation of this rule will have such items confiscated. Items will be left with the show secretary and can be picked up at the conclusion of the horse show. This policy will be strictly enforced.

Campers: Regular RV spots are available for \$45 per night; 30 Amp and 50 Amp spots are available. Access to water is limited. **Camping Flags** are to be visibly displayed in a window or door. **Camping Flags are available through show office.**

Vandalism: Vandalism of the stalls, facilities, or grounds owned by the Champions Center will result in the assessment of a \$500 fee for each incident of vandalism and any additional cost.

Damages: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to the stalls or any Champions Center Expo properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

Dogs on Show Grounds: Dogs must be on a leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.

Motorized Vehicles & Golf Cart Use: Operators of motorized vehicles must possess a valid driver's license from the state in which they reside. Violations of this rule will result in the confiscation of the vehicle and a fine of \$50. Minors who do not have a valid drivers license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid drivers license. The parent, legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank, as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages claims losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense.

Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a drivers license to operate, including but not limited to segway, hover boards and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parents, legal guardians or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Exception: wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices.

Remember, horses have the right of way!

Indoor Show Arena is 128 x 220 feet and is composed of sand and dirt mix footing.

Indoor Warm Up Arena is 120 x 60 feet and is composed of sand and dirt mix footing

Outdoor uncovered work rings (100' x 300') Sand based Arena

Unloading: After unloading all vehicles must be parked in a designated parking place for that vehicle as as unloading is completed.

Parking: Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse vans and trailers. All trailers must be parked at the north end of the stabling area. All trailers must be parked away from the building: all violator will be ticketed and towed at owners expense.

Trailer and Vehicle Parking: All trailers and vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. *Absolutely no trailer or vehicle parking in the barn or warm-up ring areas. No trailer parking between barns.* The fire code dictates that fire lanes must be left open on all sides of the barns in case of emergency.

Food Service: During the competition food service will be provided on the competition grounds, Champions Grill.

Restrooms/showers are available in the front restrooms area. Nighttime access is made by using the front doors to the restrooms located on the south side of the Champions Center at the main entrance.

Exhibitors: Please assist in maintaining clean facilities and grounds by placing litter in trash receptacles. Please place manure and used shavings from the stalls and trailers in designated areas. Do not turn horses loose in any ring on the show grounds.

Discipline: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse and the owner shall forfeit all fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to the disqualified horse. Show committee decision is final.

Protest: If you wish to file a protest, please see horse show management. There will be a charge of \$100 until the protest is resolved. If the protest is in your favor, you will be refunded the \$100. If the protest is not in your favor, you will forfeit the \$100. The owner of the horse that is being protested may be asked for registration papers.

Show Committee: The show committee reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and return any fee and/or stable fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the individual shall be referred to the show committee, whose decision shall be final. The committee reserves the right to itself, to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulation shall be decided by the Horse Show Committee, their decision to be final.

Liability: The show committee of the Summer Solstice Soiree, The Champions Center, show officials, or any sponsor will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, vendor, spectator, driver, rider, groom, attending animal, or equipment at the show. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Summer Solstice Soiree, Summer Solstice Soiree LLC, or Champions center expo will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or any injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify Summer Solstice Soiree, Summer Solstice Soiree LLC and Champions Center Expo against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

Awards: All classes ribbons to 6th place, Additional prizes on select classes, Payout on select classes, Additional Ribbons on ASHBA Select Series

Judges reserve the right to split classes for working, if size warrants for safety issues. Judges decisions are final. Formal protests can be made in writing accompanied by \$100.

Welfare of the horses exhibited here is of primary concern to our management team. We require that all horses are treated with the kindness, respect, and compassion they deserve and they should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms or their agents, must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of the horses owned and or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. No excessive use of whips or poling will be tolerated. Violators are subject to ejection from show grounds.

Horse Show Office: Will be open for Summer Solstice Soiree on Thursday for check-in, hours tbd.. The office will be open Friday at least 1 hour prior to the first session start time, and will remain open for one hour after the last class each day.

Every class offered herein will be conducted by rules, provided linked on website @ www.summersolsticesoiree.com and will be judged in accordance therewith. The show committee will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. The show committee decision is final.

Show management reserves the right to refuse entry to the show, or show grounds, to ANYONE, exhibitor or spectator, for any reason, without liability of compensation.
